Mrs Nadoels, the wife of the schoolteacher sits at the piano, her husband stands in the back row. There is another teacher at the other end behind the back row. (The name is Nadoels and not Nadels as seen in some publications). On the first row on the platform, the other end from where I sit, sits Rudolf Grant, brother of Louis, the Flying Officer mentioned in Newlyn at War; a sister of both stands in the middle row on the platform in front of a tall girl. On the same row, to the right, a sister of Robert Maesen, not Maeson. Robert Maesen was an elder colleague at the time. After the war he was a captain on board the Belgian Ostend-Dover Mail-boats; our fathers were great friends and enjoyed life in Newlyn.
