Later he became a midshipman in the East India Company, then Captain of the barque Caroline, and later a trader and master of a ship based at Van Diemen's Land. He returned to Newlyn in 1834, staying at Myrtle Cottage, his grandfather's home where he found a loving sister and a still dearer cousin, Elizabeth Bussell, his future wife. After they were married, the couple immigrated to Van Diemen's Land, although his widowed mother and sister remained at Myrtle Cottage until the 1870s when his mother died and his sister Sophia joined the family in Tasmania.
